DuPage Township Senior Committee Minutes of April 5, 2022

- I. Call to Order- Meeting was called to order at 6:07 PM.

- IV. Approval of the Agenda: Motion to Accept Christine Betschel, 2nd Ocie Koonce. Ayes by all. Motion Carried
- V. Approval of February 1, 2022 minutes: Motion to Accept: Al Legittino, 2nd, Trish Stach. Ayes by all. Motion Carried.
- VI. Public Comments: Carol Kruptka made a request to have a soda machine installed and cited that several members of the exercise group might be interested. Two other ladies, Judith Schmidt and Bernadette Youngs attended, to see what happens at these meetings. All three women filled out an application to become a member of the Senior Committee.
